### Main offering January 20, 2024 : Church Budget

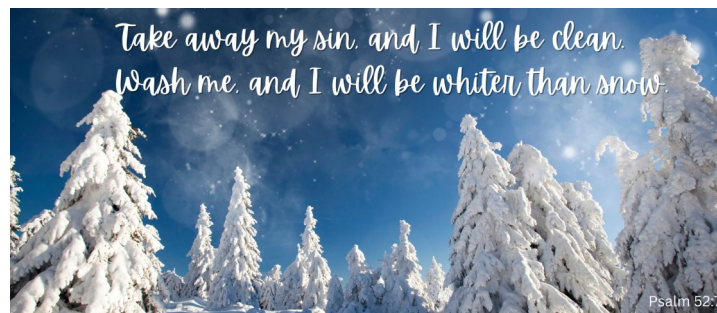
*This fund is what allows us to operate as a church. All are encouraged to contribute a regular amount on a consistent basis. See back of order of service for updates on this fund.*

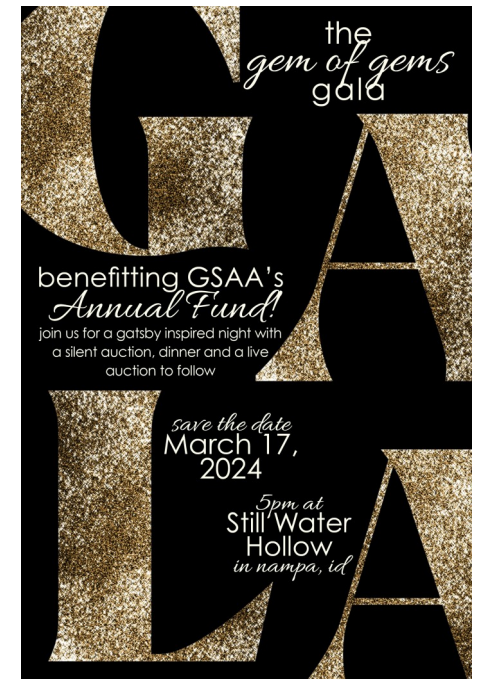
